



INTERNSHIP

at the “INTERREGIONAL ALLIANCE FOR THE RHINE-ALPINE CORRIDOR EGTC” (EUROPEAN GROUPING FOR TERRITORIAL COOPERATION)

Since the spring of 2015, the EGTC has existed as a European network for the development of the transport corridor between Rotterdam and Genoa. This is the most significant European transport corridor, connecting the economically strongest regions of Europe between the Mediterranean and the North Sea. The EGTC currently has 25 members, including cities, regions, and large ports. The exciting task of the internship involves contributing to the further expansion and development of this unique European cooperation network. This includes activities related to the management of this European network with members from six countries, as well as the preparation and design of communication activities. In spring 2025, an international conference will be organized in Strasbourg to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the EGTC; the intern will also participate in this process and in the communication of the new EGTC Strategy. Additionally, support will be provided for the lobbying network in Brussels.

Duration of the internship, working hours, location:

- From January/February 2025 until summer 2025
- Weekly working hours based on need/arrangement
- Mainly remote work and/or work at the EGTC office in Esslingen am Neckar, with possible additional travel to meetings/events in the Rhine-Alpine Corridor

Requirements:

- Interest in the practical functioning of a European network
- Language skills (fluent in English, both spoken and written; knowledge of the languages of our members – German, French, Italian, Dutch – is an advantage)
- Organizational and communication skills
- Ability to work independently
- Practical knowledge of common Microsoft programs
- Design/mapping skills are desirable but no must

Compensation: To be agreed upon within the framework of legal or study-related requirements. Travel expenses to the office in Esslingen am Neckar and events in the Rhine-Alpine Corridor will be covered.
